Island Falls Canoe Ordering and Shipping Information

Canoes are built to special order and the backlog is often more than a year. A \$500 deposit reserves a spot on the schedule, with another \$1000 due when the canoe is started. The remainder is due when the canoe is completed.

Owners frequently enjoy picking up their canoes, and this scenic region of Central Maine offers many possibilities for the first Launching. If the distance is too great or it is otherwise inconvenient to pick up, shipping can usually be arranged at a reasonable rate to any spot in North America. There is a \$75 packaging charge for preparing the canoe for transport. The actual freight bill is assessed after the canoe's safe arrival.




